Free Sample Design and Project
Instructions for Canning Jar Topper



You can add your name with your embroidery software, hand-stitch your name, or use a permanent fabric marker to write name. (the last 2 must be done after machine embroidery is complete).

Stitch design on muslin, using tear-away stabilizer under the design. Once design is completed, remove hoop from machine and tear the stabilizer away from around the outside edge of the circle. Leave the stabilizer in place on the inside of the circle. Using pinking shears cut a 6" diameter circle around the embroidery design. Using a different piece of fabric cut a 8" in diameter circle using pinking shears. Lay the embroidered circle over the 2nd piece of cut fabric. Place both pieces over the top of a canning jar lid, put a rubber band around to hold topper down and secure a piece of ribbon tied in a bow around the jar. *** (you might want to cut a piece of batting in a circle in the diameter of the jar lid, and place it directly on top of the lid before you add the embroidered fabric topper – this will poof it up a little).

Suggested uses:

* Make up several as a gift for someone who does a lot of canning. You can leave them blank, if desired, so they can add their own name, or personalize it for them.

- Makes a nice gift anytime of the year. Fill jar with homemade goodies, add the embroidered topper and give as a gift to a friend or loved one.
