Bread Cloth

Materials Needed:
Linen or other fabric
Tear Away Stabilizer
Water Soluble Pen



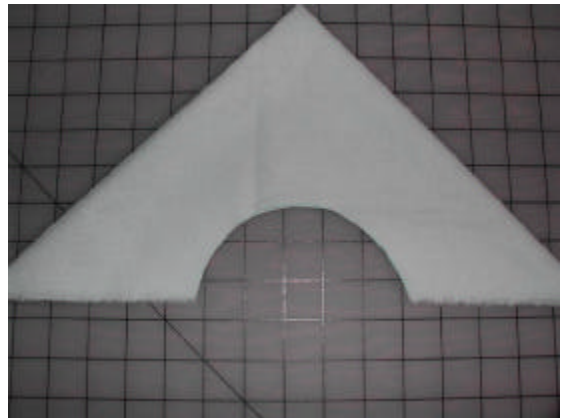
Instructions:

Cut or tear a 16" x 16" square of fabric. Fold fabric corner-to-corner, then corner-to-corner the other way as in diagram 1. Using a circle (I used a CD, and drew my half circle just a little bigger than the CD), place centered half on, half off edge of fabric and with your water-soluble pen, draw your half circle, as in diagram 2. Cut all four layers of the half-round out. Unfold and finish off edges. I serged all the edges, of mine, then after machine embroidery was completed, I turned under the serged edge and straight stitched a nice finished edge all the way around.

Hoop each pointed corner in your 4x4 hoop and stitch ribbon egg design. I stitched mine different colors in each corner. Once all four corners are complete, you can finish off the edge of bread cloth as you like. Enjoy and HAPPY EASTER!
